Attached to this email is our uniform policy and our helpful shoe guide. **Please note, uniform in EYFS is slightly different to enable children to fully access a play-based curriculum.** *EYFS shorts are available from the school office. All children should also have a pair of pumps in school in a drawstring pump bag and children in Years 1-6 should also have shorts in this bag. All PE kit must be plain black with no brand logos. Children also need a bookbag (not a rucksack) please.
