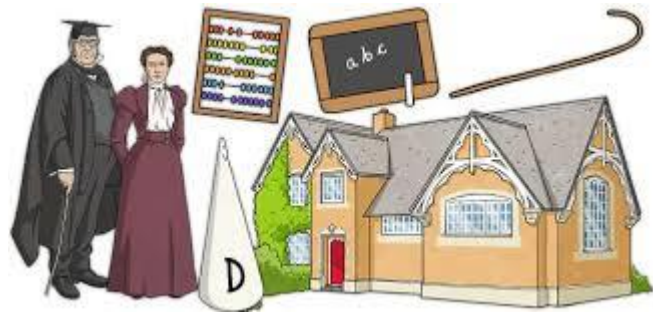
- To be taught about changes in living memory, including those that reveal aspects of change in national life.
